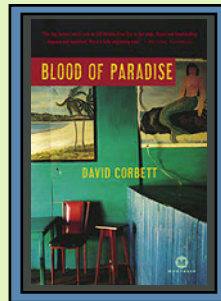

## DAVID CORBETT

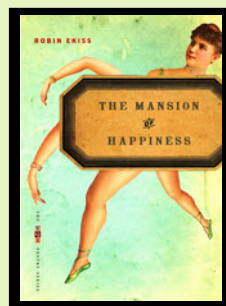
